A copy of a current passport (valid 6 months after return - October 11, 2025) is required for this trip. Please send with first deposit.

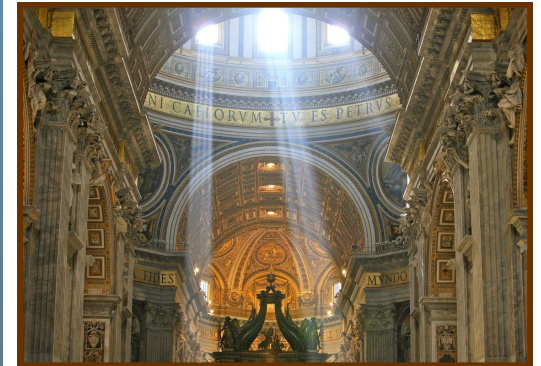

GRAND ITALY

Monday, Mar 31 ~ Day 1: Depart from MSP

Take an overnight flight to Italy.

Tuesday, Apr 1 ~ Day 2: Arrive in Rome, Italy, Begin Visits to Holy Doors

Arrive at the airport in Rome early morning. Meet our tour guide & bus driver who will escort us throughout the trip. Start the trip off with seeing our first Holy Door at St. Paul's Outside the Walls including a guided tour. On to see the Holy Door at St. John Lateran with a guided tour. After lunch see the Holy Stairs and then on to St. Mary Major (Holy door 3). Fr. Fitz will celebrate Mass at St. Mary Major and then we will check in to our hotel and have dinner. (B, D)

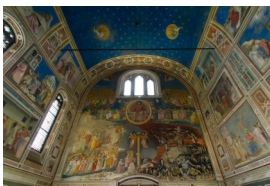
Wednesday, Apr 2 ~ Day 3: Rome, Papal Audience

After an early breakfast, head to St. Peter's Square for the Papal Audience, if available. After we will drive to the Ancient Rome area to immerse ourselves in the rich history of this remarkable city. For lunch, dine at a local café of your choice, then explore some of Rome's most iconic highlights: Saint Agnes Church, the artistry of Piazza Navona, the ancient awe-inspiring Pantheon, and famous Trevi Fountain. Conclude our day by celebrating Holy Mass before returning to the hotel for dinner and an overnight stay. (B, D)



Thursday, Apr 3 ~ Day 4: Rome. Vatican Museum & Coliseum

We will have an early Holy Mass at the St. Peter's Crypt Chapel within the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica. Time to look around



after Mass while Fr. Fitz hears confessions, if permitted. See the Holy Door at St. Peter's Basilica then have breakfast at a local café. Then a guided visit to the vast Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica. Lunch on your own in a local café before we head to the Coliseum for a guided tour. Back to the hotel for dinner (B, D)



Friday, Apr 4 ~ Day 5: Rome, Assisi

Check out of the hotel after breakfast and then drive to Assisi. Reach Santa Maria degli Angeli and celebrate Mass at the Basilica of Saint Mary of the Angels. Enjoy a guided visit by a friar of the Basilica which is home to Holy Door #5. After lunch taxi up to Assisi where we will step back into the Medieval era. Enjoy a guided walking tour of this enchanting town seeing significant sites such as the Basilica of Saint Clare, Santa Maria sopra Minerva, etc. Enjoy a wine tasting in Assisi before dinner at the hotel. (B, D)

Saturday, Apr 5 ~ Day 6: Assisi, Florence

Breakfast then check out of the hotel. Start the day with Mass. See Holy Door #6 and talk to one of the friars during a guided visit at the Basilica of Saint Francis.



Lunch on your own in a local café before heading to Florence. Check into the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

Sunday, Apr 6 ~ Day 7: Cooking Class and Florence

Breakfast at the hotel then spend an entertaining morning learning how to cook Italian style "InTavola" then enjoy what we

learned for lunch. Yum! After lunch get a guided city walking tour including the Duomo, Baptistery, Museum of Duomo and Santa Reparata. Celebrate Holy Mass in the Duomo which is also Holy Door #7. Dinner will be in a local restaurant enjoying the ambience. Return to the hotel. (B, D)

Monday, Apr 7 ~ Day 8: Florence, Ravenna

Eat breakfast before checking out of the hotel. Drive to Ravenna for a guided visit of the Arian Baptistery Dante's tomb, Saint Appolinare Nuovo, and more. Have lunch in a local restaurant of Ravenna. Celebrate Holy Mass in a local Church then drive towards Padua. Check into the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

Tuesday, Apr 8 ~ Day 9: Padua

After breakfast at the hotel head to St. Anthony's for Mass and to see Holy Door #8. Enjoy a spritz tasting experience with finger food. Have a guided visit to Saint Anthony and St. Luke's Chapel in the Basilica of Santa Giustina. Continue on to the Scrovegni Chapel for a guided tour. Enjoy a little time at leisure to walk around the city center of Padua. To the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

Wednesday, Apr 9 ~ Day 10: Padua, Venice

Breakfast at the hotel drive to Venice. Celebrate Holy Mass then see Holy Door #9 during a guided visit of Saint Mark's, Doge Palace. Lunch on your own. Have a boat ride to see the Murano Glass and then have some free time in Venice. Enjoy a farewell dinner then return to the Hotel for overnight. (B, D)

Thursday, Apr 10 ~ Day 11: Return Home

After breakfast head to the airport. Travel back to the US with deepened faith and wonderful memories of Italy's Jubilee Year.
